The 32nd Edition of the Surf Lifesaving training manual is about to be reviewed.

The manual was released in August 2003 and included the introduction of Vocational Education content linked to the Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue). This change was the first in a series of changes to bring SLSA Awards into the National Accredited Qualification structure. Version 2 of the 32nd Edition was released in August 2006 and incorporated International resuscitation changes and minor content changes.

Accordingly, this will be the first full review of the Training Manual since 2002 when the review of the 31st Edition was established. The new 33rd Edition will be released September 2008.

All sections of the organisation were invited by a circular (67/06-07 issued June 2007) to provide feedback on content, related award structure, style of the publication and layout. The key purpose of the review is identifying any gaps in content. Specifically, any gaps in information required for the related Certificate II in Public Safety assessments. Confirmation is also being sought regarding maintaining the current approach to the structure/format/publication of the Training Manual.
