**Radio Servicing**

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Summary	Radio equipment/reprogramming servicing arrangements for clubs. All clubs to drop radios to SLSCC by Friday 3 <sup>rd</sup> August
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SLSCC has arranged, on behalf of clubs, the annual service and preventative maintenance of radios plus reprogramming. 2018/19 season will see only digital radios used for Lifesaving purposes.

SLSNSW is rolling out a new Digital Radio Network for the Central Coast in which all radio communications will be migrated to this new network for the 2018/19 season.

#### Clubs are requested to:

- All digital radios need to be reprogrammed. Keep two digital radios at your club until the rest have been reprogrammed/serviced.
- On pick up of reprogrammed/serviced digital radios bring remaining two digital radios to be reprogrammed
- Take out of service - Icom radios, they will no longer be used on the digital network.

#### Radio preparation:

- Clean obvious sand, dirt and corrosion from the radio equipment
- Ensure SurfGuard records are correct for all equipment delivered
- Radios are to include aerial and battery only (no chargers)
- Complete Karera Radio Servicing form (attached)
- **Label ALL radios, batteries and removable components with club name**

#### Radio costs and Invoices:

- SLSNSW is covering the cost of the reprogramming of digital radios
- SLSCC thanks to Central Coast Council Funding will cover \$400 per club for radio servicing.
- If the cost of a clubs radio service goes over \$400 they will be invoiced for the amount.
- Clubs will be contacted for approval of any additional cost except for radio batteries. Radio batteries that need replacing will be replaced and charged without consultation.
- Clubs that miss the above deadlines will be responsible for servicing their own equipment.

**Dates:**

- Radios to be dropped at SLSCC by Friday 3rd August
