Costs per Carnival:

- \$16.50 (including GST) entry fee per competitor
- \$ 8.50 (including GST) late fee per competitor for entries not received on time.

For team entries, Clubs are only required to enter one team member for each team that is being entered in the carnival. This will streamline the administration process for both the clubs and SLSCC officials at the event.

Entries close at **9am** on the **Wednesday** before each carnival with late entries being accepted on the day of the carnival.

Clubs will be invoiced for competitors entered at the completion of each carnival.

It is mandatory that ALL competitors wear the SLSCC Freemasons florescent pink Competition Safety Vest at any SLSCC carnival.
