<b>Summary</b>	SLSA Surf Sport Officials Training
<b>Objective</b>	To provide clarification for clubs and members on how to become a SLSCC Surf Sports Official.

SLSCC Clubs urgently require members to assist with Officiating at Surf Sports Carnivals. Interested members need to be able to be impartial and most of all be able to meet new people, have fun and help make the carnival a great experience for our nippers.

This season the quota for officials at SLSCC Junior Carnivals will be one official for every nine competitors. These numbers are required to be able to safely run the carnival

SLSCC would like to encourage all interested members to register for the Technical Official Course. **You will need to be 16 years +, be a financial club member and have completed your Working with Children check.**

### **How to become a SLSCC Surf Sports Official:**

- Go to the Australian Sports Commission website. Register and complete the Online Officials Course. <https://learning.ausport.gov.au/auth/login/?returnUrl=%2F> (Print Certificate to provide as evidence of completion)
- Register through the E-Learning on SLSA Members Portal. [https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA\\_Online/modules/login/index.php](https://members.sls.com.au/SLSA_Online/modules/login/index.php)  
(There is an upfront \$60 fee to register for this course, please discuss with your club regarding a reimbursement once you have been accredited) Please follow instructions attached.
- Complete the **SLS Technical Official** E-Learning Course. (Print copy of Certificate to provide as evidence of completion)
- Register via the SLSCC website to attend one of the following Face to Face Official Information nights to be held at SLSCC. Registered members must bring printed certificate of completion x 2 along to this Information Night. (Certificates required ASC and SLS Official Course)
