



2020-2021 Streets Surf Boat Series



Surf Life Saving Central Coast in partnership with Streets would like to invite all Central Coast and Hunter clubs to enter the 2020-2021 Streets Surf Boat Series.

Rounds, Dates & Venues:

1. Saturday 24 th October 2020	Catherine Hill Bay	Long course
2. Saturday 14 th November 2020	TBC	Long course
3. Saturday 5 th December 2020	Scotts Head	Long course
4. Sunday 6 th December 2020	Scotts Head	Long course
5. Saturday 9 th January 20201	Nobbys Beach	Long course
6. Saturday 13 February 20201	Ocean Beach	Long course
7. Saturday 27 March 2021	Soldiers (Presentation)	Long course

Please read the following rules and conditions of entry to the series and all entries from clubs will only be accepted with crews agreeing to compete under these competition rules.

Competition Rules:

1. Entries for each round **MUST** be in by the Monday prior to the carnival.
2. Sweep/Team Managers meeting will take place with the referee at each round at 7.45am.
3. The gun will be fired at 8.00am sharp to start the first event of the competition. If boats have been marshalled in a timely manner, then it remains the responsibility of the club to be in position and ready to start.
4. Rounds:
 - a) All rounds will run with three (3) heats, with the top six (6) to go to the final.
 - b) If less than six (6) crews in a division, consideration to running a four (4) x boat final.
 - c) Events are subject to change due to conditions on the day at the discretion of the Referee.
5. The age limit for Masters Male is set at a minimum 160yrs division (no 120yrs crews).
The age limit for Masters Female are as per State (120ys plus)
6. If a club wishes to enter more than one Reserve Crew at each round, there must be a competing Open Male crew from that Club.
7. Double dipping will be allowed. Any crew that withdraws from one of the events on the day, other than for an injury reported to the Referee, may lose the points for that day.
8. Team members will be supplied with a Lycra singlet. This is to be worn during all competition and warm ups.
9. All other regulation as set out in the 35th Edition Surf Life Saving Australia competition manual and any subsequent amendments and bulletins from SLSA will apply.
10. All clubs are to be aware of the [Helmet Policy](#) and [PFD policy](#)



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11. Categories will comprise U19 Male, U19 Female, U23 Male, U23 Female, Open Male, Open Female, Reserves Male, Reserves Female, Masters Female and Masters Male, Composite.
12. Only Surf Life Saving Central Coast and Hunter Branch clubs will be eligible to contest the series.
13. Racing order on the day will be Open Male, Open Female, U19 Male, U19 Female, Reserve Male, Reserve Female, U23 Female, U23 Male, Master Female & Master Male and Composite Crews. This order may be changed at the discretion of the Boat Referee
14. A copy of the previous round's Pointscore will be available to view at each round.
15. Sweeps accreditation must be compliant by 31 Decembers 2019;
All sweeps must have their SLSA sweeps accreditation number and SLSA coaching certificate. These numbers must be entered on the entry form. No sweep will be able to compete without both these certificates. (Proof of coaching course attended pre-season must be provided).
16. Any rowers, in excess of the 4 crew members, must be fully entered on the entry form and listed as 'reserve'. Where there are 2 or more reserves, please email support@slscc.com.au the details of each additional reserve. The email needs to include competitor name, boat crew name, division, proficiency date, shirt size and phone number for the additional reserves so they can be entered.
17. The elected boat panel or their proxies will address any issue on the day and report back to the referee for direction.

Administration

Entry Fee: \$250.00 (GST inclusive) per crew for the series.

Entry fee includes a T-shirt and Competitor Rash Vest but must be received by the closing date.

Entries received after the closing date, receive only a Competitor Rash Vest.

Shirt sizes must be included on the entry form.

A late entry fee of \$55.00 (GST inclusive) will be charged after the closing date.

Entry is via SEMS this year. You will need to enter for each carnival.

Officials

Clubs with 3 or more competing crews must supply a minimum of one level 1 accredited official. The referee/chief judge will allocate positions on the day.

Sponsorship:

The series is sponsored by Streets and all crews are required to wear the sponsored rash vest for each race. Crews are required to display Streets sponsors' stickers on craft if supplied.

No conflicting sponsor signage may be displayed or worn by competitors in competition.



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Series Entries:

The 2020-2021 season entries will be completed using the SEMS.

A separate entry must be completed for each Boat Crew that includes the Boat Crew name, contact email address and mobile number. If a club has more than one crew in a division, each crew must be identified with a name eg "Gold", "Rats" etc. and that crew must keep that name for the whole series.

On-Day Entries:
