The 2021/2022 Newcastle Permanent Surf Life Saving Central Coast Junior Championships will be held over the two days of Saturday 5th and Sunday 6th February 2022 at Avoca Beach.

The carnival will be split into two days with sand events and inclusive nippers on the Saturday and water events on the Sunday.

This decision has been made for efficiencies and current pandemic conditions.

NOTE: The Cameron Relay will be a 4 person event (1 x swimmer, 1 x board paddler, 2 x runners) • In the Cameron Relays as a minimum, a female must take the position of either board paddler or swimmer. There should be both a Male and Female runner.

Competitors can compete up one age group for team events



A2 RESTRICTED OF EVENTS

To align with NSW Age Championships, clubs will require an U15 to compete in the all age events. As they are competing in Open Branch Championships there will be no cost for all age relay for the U15 competitors.

- a) All Age Beach Relay Race: 1 team per club (U9 to U15)
 - All Age Beach Relay (U9 to U15)
 - One (1) team per club.
 - The order will be U9 (1), U10 (2), U11 (3), U12 (4), U13 (5), U14 (6) & U15 (7).
 - A reminder that as this is an ALL AGE event, competitors must compete in their own age group and are not allowed to compete up an age. E.g. an U11 cannot do the U12 leg.
 - There will be a minimum of three females.
- b) All Age Board Relay Race: 1 team per club (U9 to U15)
 - All Age Board Relay (U9 to U15)
 - The order will be U9 (1), U10 (2), U11 (3), U12 (4), U13 (5), U14 (6) & U15 (7).
 - Competitors' arms must be marked with the number.
 - A reminder that as this is an ALL AGE event, competitors must compete in their own age group and are not allowed to compete up an age. E.g. an U11 cannot do the U12 leg.
 - There will be a minimum of three females.
- c) **Signals:** 2 competitors per club One male & One female

NOTE: No favoured consideration will be given to competitors who attempt to compete in more than one [1] area (Events will not be delayed for this reason).



SECTION B - ENTRY CONDITIONS

B1 **MEMBERSHIP**

All competitors entered into these Championships must be financial and have completed SLSA approved membership forms to register as members of the club for which they are entered.

B2 PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL COMPETITORS

Prior to competing at the 2021-2022 Newcastle Permanent Junior Championships, competitors must have completed the appropriate Surf Education Award or Surf Rescue award and be proficient to the requirements of their respective age group.

Surf Life Saving Central Coast reserves the right to conduct random or detailed audits of entries and under such circumstances, the selected clubs will be required to submit appropriate documentation to substantiate the eligibility of those members entered.

B3 RESTRICTIONS AND PROVISIONS

The following restrictions shall apply in regard to nominations and competition in the various events:

- a) All events shall be contested by teams and individuals representing Clubs only.
- b) Notwithstanding the provisions of "Substitution of Competitors" as provided for under General Competitive Conditions in the 37th revised edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual, it shall be possible for a club, in the event of the withdrawal of any member of a team, to replace such member of the team.
- c) This provision is subject to the replacement member appearing on the Entry System and meeting all conditions of entry.
- d) Competitors from clubs other than Surf Life Saving Central Coast (SLSCC) affiliated clubs may not enter or compete.
- e) No Break rule for U12 and up.

B4 CARNIVAL OFFICIALS

a) To ensure sufficient officials are available for Junior Championships, a quota system will be implemented whereby clubs must provide accredited officials at the ratio of:

1 Official per each 9 competitors

b) Officials must register their preferred area using the online Jotform sent out prior to the carnival

c) Registrations close on Wednesday 2nd February at 9.00am.

NOTE: Clubs who do not comply with the above requirements will not be permitted to start in these championships until they satisfy these conditions of entry.

Each Official should report to the Administration area on the day of the championships to sign on.



B5 WATER SAFETY PERSONNEL

a) To ensure that sufficient water safety is provided for these championships a quota system will be implemented whereby clubs must provide qualified Water Safety personnel at the ratio of :

0-5	Nil
6-10	1
11-20	2
21-30	3
31-45	4
46-60	5
61-75	6
76-90	7
91+	8

b) Each Water Safety person should report to the Water Safety Co-ordinator each day of the championships for their allocation of duties. This requirement is in addition to (clause B4 of this circular) Carnival Officials.

NOTE: Clubs who do not comply with the above requirements will not be permitted to start in these championships until they satisfy these conditions of entry.

B6 HI VIS SAFETY VESTS

The fluorescent **FREEMASONS SPONSORED** competitor safety vests from SLSCC, will be **mandatory** for all competitors to wear in all water events. No other vest will be accepted for competition under any circumstances.

SECTION C - ENTRIES

C1 ENTRY CLOSURE

a) Club entries must be submitted using SEMS which is open and no later than **Wednesday 2**nd **February. 9am.**

C2 ENTRY REGISTRATIONS

a) Entries may be altered by the clubs at any time up to closing date after which time only team changes may be made without penalty.

C3 ENTRY FEES

Entry fees have been established on the estimated number of competitors entering these Central Coast Championships to offset the cost of conducting the Championships.

- a) Accordingly, the cost for entry into these Championships is: **\$22.00** per competitor (irrespective of the number of events entered in each).
- b) A club's total entry fee for these Championships will be established by the number of competitors listed on the entry system multiplied by the appropriate fee based on entries as at 2nd February 2022.

No. of competitors @ \$22.00 each

A pro-forma invoice will be produced within SEMS.

c) Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in these Championships.



d) When all entries are processed, a **Tax Invoice** will be generated by SLSCC in accordance with the Entry Fee instructions and including any late and additional entry fees owing by a club.

C4 LATE ENTRIES

There will be not late entries taken on the day

C5 PENALTIES – BREACH OF ENTRY REGULATIONS

- a) It is mandatory that ALL competitors are listed in the Club's entries.
- b) Entry of competitors who are ineligible have penalties provided for as follows:
 - The penalty for Breach of Entry Regulations for these Championships will be the automatic rejection of those persons found to be in breach of regulations and the forfeiture of their entry fees.
 - ii. Application of the automatic penalty will not preclude further disciplinary action by Surf Life Saving Central Coast against Clubs or individuals if deemed appropriate.



CHECK LIST

The following has been designed to assist the Club Officer to complete the necessary entry forms for members wishing to compete at the 2021 Newcastle Permanent Surf Life Saving Central Coast Junior Championships.

- 1. Ensure that the following information contained in this Circular has been read thoroughly and the conditions relevant to entries adhered to.
- 2. Entries have been entered using SEMS by 9am Wednesday 2 February
- 3. Ensure Competition Official Registrations are entered via link for a jot form sent by branch the closing date (at the correct ratio).
- 4. Make sure all U12 and up know there is a NO break rule.
