Live Heats

As previously advised, Live Heats will be in operation at this carnival. Key Live heats information is listed below:

- All competitors will be allocated a wristband on the day at the Live Heats sign on desk located undercover at Terrigal SLSC.
- NO WRISTBAND = NO COMPETITION.
- The sign on desk will be open from 7am to 9am. ALL COMPETITORS ARE TO CHECK IN AT THE DESK UPON ARRIVAL.
- Clubs will be invoiced for the first issued wristband for each competitor for the 2022/23 Surf Sports season.
- Non-SLSCC competitors will have purchased a wristband via their online registration to be issued on the day or bring their previously issued wristband.
- Wristbands are to be worn for the duration of the event.
- Each wristband is allocated to the individual competitor.
- Wristbands will be scanned using mobile phones operated by our SLSCC officials for each competitor at both the commencement (marshalling) and conclusion (resulting) of a race.

Event Outline – Survivor

This Ironperson is a 2 race format.

Each race consisting of a swim leg, a board leg and 2 transition run legs.

Order will be determined on the day.

The finishing order in race 1 determines the starting order for race 2.

The time elapsing between each competitor crossing the line will equal the handicap start times for race 2.

Race 2 will commence when the last competitor finishes race 1.

e.g. Race 1 1st Place – 0 seconds

2nd Place – 8 seconds behind winner

3rd place – 12 seconds behind winner

4th place – 22 seconds behind winner

5th place – 30 seconds behind winner Etc.

Race 2 start order

1st place race 1 starts on “Go”.

2nd place Race 1 starts on 8 seconds.

3rd place Race 1 starts on 12 seconds

4th place Race 1 starts on 22 seconds.

5th place Race 1 starts on 30 seconds. Etc.

There are no series points allocated for Ironperson race 1. The points and medals will be allocated according to the results of race 2.
