Summary	The Australian Titles 2023 are being held in Scarborough WA. Surf Life Saving Central Coast is currently sourcing containers to assist Central Coast Competitors transport their gear and equipment (Boards and Skis).

Details

Surf Life Saving Central Coast is currently sourcing a container(s) to assist the Central Coast competitor's transport their gear and equipment to the Australian Titles in Scarborough, Western Australia and return.

To cover the expense for transportation of this Gear & Equipment, competitors will be charged a fee per craft that they are taking. At this point in time the costs for return craft transportation will be as follows and will be on a first in - first served basis:

- Boards \$ 150.00
- Skis - \$ 400.00
- Double Skis - \$ 600.00

Clubs will be invoiced for the craft expenses of their members and then it will be up to the club to chase up their members craft fee or absorb the costs themselves.

As there are limited spots available full payment will be invoiced on 7th of December 2022.

Please note that there is no insurance for individual craft and the only insurance available is if the entire container is lost. Individuals will be responsible for wrapping and packing their board when it is time. Should individuals require insurance on craft they will need to enquire with their own insurance company.

The anticipated departure date will be 10th March 2023, arriving in Perth approx. 23rd of March 2023. Craft is expected to be returned to the Coast on 20th April 2023. All these dates are approximates and can change due to train timetables. Craft WILL arrive in Perth prior to the commencement of competition.

As this is a cost only basis and to remain fair, there can be no refunds available should someone fill a spot and not proceed, unless their spot can be filled from another competitor and this will need to be paid to branch prior to any refund. The prices of transport are subject to change due to fuel increases and this cost, if incurred, will be passed onto clubs for competitors to pay.

Surf Life Saving Central Coast will only be sending full containers. No half containers can be sent, meaning if there is interest in one and a half containers, only one full one will be commissioned and some will miss out. If there is insufficient interest in filling at least one container then none will be commissioned.
