Live Heats

As previously advised, Live Heats will be in operation at this carnival. Key Live heats information is listed below:

- All competitors will be allocated a wristband on the day at the Live Heats sign on desk at North Entrance SLSC.
- NO WRISTBAND = NO COMPETITION.
- The sign on desk will be open from 7am to 7:45am. Competitors who already have a
 wristband aren't required to report to the sign on desk they can head to marshalling for
 their first event.
- Clubs will be invoiced for the first issued wristband for each competitor for the 2022/23 Surf Sports season.
- Wristbands are to be warn for the duration of the event.
- Each wristband is allocated to the individual competitor.
- Wristbands will be scanned using mobile phones operated by our SLSCC officials for each competitor at both the commencement (marshalling) and conclusion (resulting) of a race.
