**NOTE:** Teams entered in 'mixed gender' Cameron 4 person must have a least one female board paddler or swimmer. Max two teams per club.

# **A2 RESTRICTION OF EVENTS**

Club entries to events are restricted as follows:

**All Age Beach Relay (U9 to U14)** – One (1) team per club. The order will be U9 (1), U10 (2), U11 (3), U12 (4), U13 (5) & U14 (6). There will be a minimum of three females.

All Age Board Relay (U9 to U14) – One (1) team per club. The order will be U9 (1), U10 (2), U11 (3), U12 (4), U13 (5) & U14 (6). Competitors' arms must be marked with the number. There will be a minimum of 3 females.

A reminder that as the above events are "ALL AGE" events, competitors must compete in their own age group and are not allowed to compete up an age. E.g. an U11 cannot do the U12 leg.

**Signals:** 2 competitors per club – One male & One female

NOTE: No favoured consideration will be given to competitors who attempt to compete in more than one [1] area (Events will not be delayed for this reason).

#### **SECTION B – ENTRY CONDITIONS**

# B1 MEMBERSHIP

All competitors entered into these Championships must be financial and have completed SLSA approved membership forms to register as members of the club for which they are entered.

# **B2 PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL COMPETITORS**

Prior to competing at the 2022-2023 Newcastle Permanent Age Championships, competitors must have completed the appropriate Surf Education Award or Surf Rescue award and be proficient to the requirements of their respective age group.

Surf Life Saving Central Coast reserves the right to conduct random or detailed audits of entries and under such circumstances, the selected clubs will be required to submit appropriate documentation to substantiate the eligibility of those members entered.

# B3 RESTRICTIONS AND PROVISIONS

The following restrictions shall apply in regard to nominations and competition in the various events:

- a. All events shall be contested by teams and individuals representing Clubs only.
- b. Notwithstanding the provisions of "Substitution of Competitors" as provided for under General Competitive Conditions in the 37<sup>th</sup> revised edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual, it shall be possible for a club, in the event of the withdrawal of any member of a team, to replace such member of the team.
- c. This provision is subject to the replacement member appearing on the Entry System and meeting all conditions of entry.
- d. Competitors from clubs other than Surf Life Saving Central Coast (SLSCC) affiliated clubs may not enter or compete.



#### **B4 CARNIVAL OFFICIALS**

Officials quota's are as highlighted in Circular-1532-202223-Water-Safety-and-Official-Ratios.pdf (slscc.com.au)

Officials must register via the Jotform provided within the "Final Event Informaton" distributed 3 days before the carnival.

NOTE: Clubs who do not comply with the above requirements will not be permitted to start in these championships until they satisfy these conditions of entry.

Each Official should report to the Administration area on the day of the championships to sign on.

# B5 WATER SAFETY PERSONNEL

Water Safety quota's are as highlighted in Circular-1532-202223-Water-Safety-and-Official-Ratios.pdf (slscc.com.au)

Each Water Safety person should report to the Water Safety Co-ordinator each day of b. the championships for their allocation of duties. This requirement is in addition to (clause B4 of this circular) Carnival Officials.

NOTE: Clubs who do not comply with the above requirements will not be permitted to start in these championships until they satisfy these conditions of entry.

### **B6 HI VIS SAFETY VESTS**

The fluorescent **NEWCASTLE PERM/FREEMASONS SPONSORED** competitor safety vests from SLSCC, will be mandatory for all competitors to wear in all water events. No other vest will be accepted for competition under any circumstances.

# **SECTION C – ENTRIES**

#### C1 ENTRY CLOSURE

Club entries must be submitted using Carnival Manager no later than Wednesday 8th of February 2023 at 9am.

No Late entries will be accepted.

# **C2 ENTRY REGISTRATIONS**

- Entries may be altered by the clubs at any time up to closing date, after which time only team changes may be made without penalty.
- Competitors must report to the registration table to have their name marked off and a stamp placed on their arm. Competitors shall not start a race without this identification.
- Full Teams with all team members names must be entered into SEMS for Live Heats purposes.

#### C3 ENTRY FEES

Entry fees have been established on the estimated number of competitors entering these Central Coast Championships to offset the cost of conducting the Championships.

- Accordingly, the cost for entry into these Championships is: \$18.00 per competitor (irrespective of the number of events entered in each).
- A club's total entry fee for these Championships will be established by the number of competitors listed on the entry system multiplied by the appropriate fee.

# No. of competitors @ \$18.00 each

A pro-forma invoice will be produced within SEMS.

- Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in these C. Championships.
- When all entries are processed, a Tax Invoice will be generated by SLSCC in accordance with the Entry Fee instructions and including any late and additional entry fees owing by a club.









### **C4 LATE ENTRIES**

There will be not late entries taken on the day

# C5 PENALTIES - BREACH OF ENTRY REGULATIONS

- a. It is mandatory that ALL competitors are listed in the Club's entries.
- b. Entry of competitors who are ineligible have penalties provided for as follows:
  - i.The penalty for Breach of Entry Regulations for these Championships will be the automatic rejection of those persons found to be in breach of regulations and the forfeiture of their entry fees.
  - ii. Application of the automatic penalty will not preclude further disciplinary action by Surf Life Saving Central Coast against Clubs or individuals if deemed appropriate.

# **CHECK LIST**

- 2. Entries have been entered using SEMS by 9am Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February 2023
- 3. Ensure Competition Official Registrations are entered via link for a Jotform sent by branch in the "Final Event Information" 3 days before the carnival.
