Summary	The Newcastle Permanent Junior Lifesaver of the Year Program recognises the outstanding contributions U14 Central Coast member provide to their club and the community. Interviews will be run on Monday and nominees must be available in person to attend. Last season's JLOTY winners will host an information session to explain the process candidates go through in preparation and on the Interview Day.
Actions	Central Coast Clubs are to nominate 1 male and 1 female to represent the club using the nomination form below. Only one nomination form from clubs will be accepted.

Surf Life Saving Central Coast is seeking nominations for the 2022-2023 Newcastle Permanent Junior Lifesaver of the Year award. The award is an ideal opportunity for clubs to recognise their Under 14 member's achievements in Surf Life Saving and the contributions they have made to Surf Life Saving at all levels and in the community.

All Under 14 members who believe they could be the next Central Coast Junior Lifesaver of the Year should apply through their club. The male and female Branch winners will progress to the SLSNSW Junior Lifesaver of the Year Development Camp. The Branch JLOTY winners will carry out some responsibilities over the following season, such as media, Raising of the Flags, mentoring others etc and nominees must be aware of these expectations.

The JLOTY winners are awarded at the Newcastle Permanent Junior Branch Carnival, and will also be invited to the annual SLSCC Awards of Excellence evening where they will be presented with a trophy and prizes. Traditionally this has been a racing mal, however after feedback this is being reviewed this year and will be a prize as nominated by SLSCC Board.

Please note nominees must have completed their SRC, be proficient, and be financial Central Coast members to be eligible for the Junior Lifesaver of the Year award. Successful applicants will need to be available for an interview on Monday 9th January 2023. SLSCC strongly encourage all clubs to ensure they nominate their U14 members for this great acknowledgement of their efforts.

The Nomination Process – Closing Date Extended Thursday 15th December 2022

Clubs are invited to submit one female and one male nominee for the 2022-2023 SLSCC Junior Lifesaver of the Year award who meet the following criteria.

1. Current financial member of Surf Life Saving Central Coast
2. Is proficient in the Surf Rescue Certificate on the Interview Day.
3. Available to attend the interview day in person.

Information Night – (New Date) Monday 19th December 2022

Each year SLSCC holds an information night for clubs two representatives that runs for one hour. The night provides insight and tips into what the interview day is like from first-hand accounts and outlines the interview day's proceedings. The interview process is divided up into a theory test, signals, a CPR scenario, and an interview which will be conducted by independent SLSCC assessors/personnel and Newcastle Permanent staff.
