Summary of Changes

U15 to Open Branch Championships

The order of events for Saturday the 28th of January has had the following changes:

- Lifesaver Relay will be held at the start of the water program at 9:00am.
- Surf Belt and Rescue Tube Rescue events have been moved to the end of the water program after the Board Rescue events.

Competition start times

- To ensure completion of events, start times have been altered as follows:
 - o Sand Events: 6:30am report for 7:00am start.
 - o Water Events: 8:30am report for 9:00am start.

Lifesaving Championships

- Champion Lifesaver competitors have been advised previously that there was "no live patient" required. Competitors WILL require to bring a "live patient". The same patient may be used by all competitors from that club.
- Official requirements has been updated to: "Officials, as a minimum requirement, must have a current Core Official accreditation. The Lifesaving Championships will also accept officials who are only ARTC qualified". No "Assessor" qualification is required as previously advised.
