Awards of Excellence

- Review awards and report on annual Awards of Excellence night.

- Oversee a review of awards criteria

Junior Lifesaver Program

- In consultation with the support officer, coordinate the Junior Life Saver program.
- Oversee the Junior Lifesaver Award process.

Retention and Recruitment

- Develop member recruitment and retention strategies and programs
- Promote SLSCC recruitment and retention strategies and programs

Recognition

- Encourage clubs to endorse member achievements in Surf Life Saving
- Encourage clubs to nominate members for SLS recognition awards at all levels
- Encourage clubs to nominate members for life membership
- Develop new recognition awards.

Rookie Program

- Ensure that there is a branch Rookie Coordinator
- Liaise with club Rookie coordinators
- Monitor each clubs Rookie programs and obtain monthly reports for them
- Liaise with the project officer to ensure the organisation and development of the Rookie Program
- Review Rookie retention rates

Administration

- Be a Manager for the BOMS
- Liaise with the Project Officer
- As required, assist in youth development activities.
- Be prepared to undertake additional programs and give advice or same when so requested by the Director of Membership Services.
- Ensure the presentation of relevant seminars associated with portfolio
- Advise the Board upon reports and recommendations received from officers, appropriate staff, members and other forums, established from time to time to consider and recommend upon member development matters.
- Attend the BOMS meetings and provide monthly reports
- Be prepared to attend meetings, conferences and forums which are convened and will affect upon member development.
- Contribute to an annual review of the Board of Membership Services Programs
