During the 2022/23 season feedback was provided on ways the SLSCC Patrol Competition could be enhanced and ensure it remains fit for purpose. It was decided by the SLSCC Board and Club Presidents at the time to undertake a full review of the Patrol Competition format and process following the end of the 22/23 season to allow time for any changes to be implemented prior to the next season.

It is important that we look for continual improvement and that any activities provide benefit to our members and uplift the skills if our Lifesavers. On this basis the SLSCC Board of Education proposes to workshop the Patrol Competition format which is currently run as 4 rounds of each Patrol season using set criteria. The workshop will be held on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> July at Branch office, Tuggerah starting at 6pm.

To enable discussion in a workshop environment it is requested that clubs send a maximum of two representatives from Executive board to attend. Ideally this would include at least one representative from Education or Lifesaving.
