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### Competition Summary

- Competitor Sign in commences: 6:30am (IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A LIVE HEATS WRISTBAND, YOU DON'T NEED TO SIGN ON – JUST GO STRAIGHT TO YOUR COMPETITION AREA)
- U8 Competitors DON'T NEED A LIVE HEATS BAND.
- Wristbands can be purchased to those who need one and will be available for purchase for \$5.00 via EFTPOS or CASH (exact money only) for those who require one.
- No wristbands will be 'issued' for free.
- Wristbands from prior events or season can be re-used for the same competitor.
- **Marshalling Report Time:**
  - R and R - 6:45am report time for 7:00am START.
  - 1km Beach Runs - 7:15am for a 7:30am start.
  - 7:45am for All Age Relays with an 8:00am start.
  - 8:15am for main carnival with an 8:30am start.
- All events are subject to change.
