Clubs are encouraged to use this program as a method of recognising members who have the potential to develop skills further by working with like-minded youth. The Program is a 2 night sleep over camp and participants will be expected to stay for the entire program from Friday 15th November to Sunday 17th November 2024.

Once online nominations have closed, clubs will be sent their members nominations for ranking. Clubs will be allocated four (4) positions in the program and should rank all other interested applicants in preferential order. It would be ideal to have two male and two female applicants per club. Positions not filled will be allocated to the most promising applicants from other clubs.


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#### Overview

## Who Can Apply?

The Rookie Program targets U13 - U14 age group members who have qualities that can be developed to enhance their future and that of surf lifesaving. It is also geared toward creating greater awareness of opportunities for these members. Potential participants can come from a range of different backgrounds, interests and areas of focus within the club environment.

# Applicants must be:

- In the current U13 or U14 age group
- A current 2024/2025 financial member of a Central Coast Branch club
- Available for the duration of the camp
- Committed to full participation in the program

### Cost

A subsidised fee has been arranged and SLSCC will invoice the clubs \$150.00 for each participant. It is up to each club and participant to agree on how much each party will contribute.


