- Attend regular BOLS meetings and provide a report on UAV operations
- Provide advice and recommendations on UAV operations and requests to BOLS as required
- Be available for additional UAV programs, meetings, conferences and forums as requested
- Contribute to an annual review of the Board of Life Saving
- Liaise with patrol Duty Officers, Patrol Captains and carnival SEMC
- Liaise and communicate with Branch Support Officer
